- In high school you earn grades and credits for each class.
- You must pass all classes with a grade of D or better.
- You must earn 220 credits in the required categories.


## How are credits earned in high school?

- Students earn credits each semester (2 semesters in a school year)
- Each semester is worth 30 credits $/ 5$ credits for each class (same 6 classes all year; August-May)
- 60 credits for each school year

Courses that students must complete (with a grade of $C$ or better) to be minimally eligible for admission to the University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU).
