# GRADUATION CEREMONY & DIPLOMA

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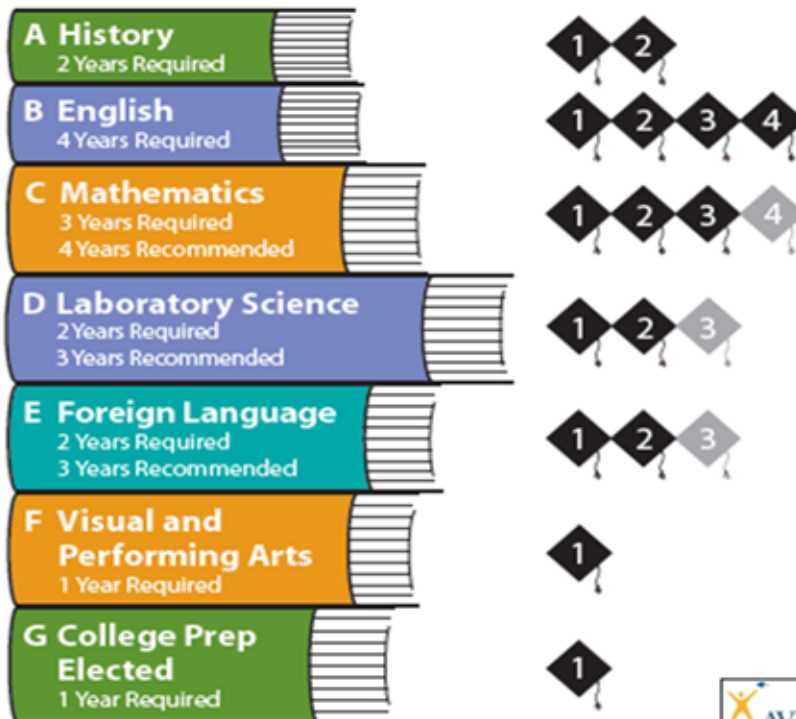
- Core Classes that are not passed must be made up (Adult School, Cyber High, etc.)

# COLLEGES & DEGREES

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## ● Types of Colleges/Schools

- Vocational
- Community College (Junior College)
- 4 yr University
  - UC (research university) and CSU (teaching university)
- Professional (Medical, Law, etc.)

## ● Degrees:

- Certificates (3 months to 18 months)
- Associates (2 year degree)
- Bachelors (4 year degree)
- Masters (additional 2 years after Bachelors degree)
- Professional/PhD (varies from program to program)

# PAYING FOR COLLEGE

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## ◉ Financial Aid (FAFSA & Cal Grant GPA)

- Financial Need
  - ❖ (EFC – Expected Family Contribution)
- Grants (Pell and Cal Grants)
  - ❖ Money given, usually because of financial need
- Scholarships
  - ❖ Money awarded for academic achievement or an outstanding talent/skill
- Work Study (FAFSA question)
  - ❖ Money earned at a part-time job on campus
- Loans
  - ❖ Money borrowed that must be repaid
