How are credits earned in high school?

- Students earn credits each semester (2 semesters in a school year)
- Each semester is worth 30 credits /5 credits for each class (same 6 classes all year; August-May)
- 60 credits for each school year

Tracy Unified Graduation Requirements

- In high school you earn grades and credits for each class.
- You must pass all classes with a grade of D or better.
- You must earn 220 credits in the required categories.

A-G Requirements

Courses that students must complete (with a grade of C or better) to be minimally eligible for admission to the University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU).

- A – History 2 years
- B – English 4 years
- C – Math 3 years (4 years recommended)
- D – Lab Science 2 years
- E – Foreign Language 2 years
- F – Visual & Performing Arts 1 year
- G – College Prep Elective 1 year
- Must earn a C or better in all A-G courses

In order to begin the enrollment process at Kimball High School the following paperwork and documentation is required and must be received by the counseling office:

Step 1

Complete the Online Enrollment found at <https://www.tracy.k12.ca.us>, navigate to the Parent tab and click on "Aeries Online Enrollment". Follow the instructions found on that page to complete the enrollment process. On the year selection page, please select 2021-2022. Note: this can take 20-30 minutes to complete and can be done on any computer, laptop, tablet or smart phone. Once completed, print and sign the Enrollment Confirmation and attach the required documents listed in Step 2, to this cover sheet.

Step 2

Please attach and submit COPIES of the following items to this cover sheet. Originals cannot be returned.

- Signed Enrollment Confirmation (From Step 1)
- Birth Certificate (copies only please)
- Parent/Guardian Photo ID
- Immunization Records Physician stamped from doctor's office
- Proof of Address
 - Student Residency Questionnaire (Attached)
 - Current Mortgage Statement/Rental Agreement or Property Tax Bill
 - Current Utility Bill (PG&E, City Water, Cable)
